



PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Construction of a new, 21-storey building at 370 which includes 263 new units, a new exercise room and pool deck
- Extension of the north side of the existing building at 350 to add 77 new units (four units per floor). New passage way within existing building.
- Corridor refurbishment to all floors 350 and 390
- Underground utilities and services works. There will not be any disruption to resident's or businesses services during these works.



PLEASE NOTE

There will be noise, dust and vibration associated with the construction of this project. Multiplex has a comprehensive control plan in place to mitigate the impact of construction on the community and will ensure all work is within acceptable levels and meets the requirements of all applicable by-laws.



PROGRESS UPDATE

Construction started on site in June 1st, 2021.
Work completed to-date includes:

- Building 370 & 350 Topped Out .
- Building 370 Architectural precast panels installation is in progress. The East and West podiums of Building 370 are complete, Mian Tower South Façade – panels are installed up to Floor 15th, East Façade – panels are install up to 9th North Façade – panels are installed up to 15th Floor.
- Building 350 Architectural precast panels installation is in progress. North and West Façades – panels are installed up to 13th Floor
- Building 370 Windows installation commenced and is well underway on 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th floors.
- Roofing work is in progress on the existing Building 350 and 390 roofs.
- Structural canopy framing on Building 350 roof is complete.
- Existing RTU relocation is underway on the existing roofs of buildings 350 & 390 to enable roofing membrane installation.
- Building 350 and 390 South Retail Areas under construction. Exterior envelop works are well underway.
- Landscape work is in progress within Buildings 350 and 390 South Retail Areas
- Enbridge Gas distribution piping installation is in progress.
- Toronto Hydro power connection and main electrical room in building 370 energization commence.
