AND UPON the Third Claimant undertaking that it will pay any damages sustained by the Defendants in consequence of this Order, should it transpire that the Order should not have been made, which the Court considers the Claimants should pay

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

THE INJUNCTION

(1) the Defendants must not until further order, without the consent of the Claimants or other lawful authority, enter or remain upon any part of the land as shown edged red on the plan at Schedule 2 to this Order as demarcated from time to time by hoarding or security fencing (the "Elephant and Castle Construction Site").

VARIATION OR DISCHARGE OF THIS ORDER

The Defendants and any person affected by this Order, may apply to vary or discharge this Order upon giving 48 hours' notice in writing to the Claimants' solicitors at Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP, One Wood Street, London, EC2V 7WS (Ref: Stuart Wortley tel: 020 7919 0969; email: stuartwortley@eversheds-sutherland.com).

INTERPRETATION OF THIS ORDER

(3) A Defendant who is ordered not to do something must not do it him/herself or in any other way. He/she must not do it through another acting on his/her behalf or on his/her instructions or with his/her encouragement.

- (4) The Claimants shall:-
 - (a) post notice of this Order in the locations of the existing warning notices referred to in paragraphs (5) and (6) of the Order dated 1 August 2023;

- (6) Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, service by the Claimants of any application or Order or other document that should be served in these proceedings, may be effected by:-
 - (a) posting notice thereof in the locations referred to in paragraph (4)(a) above;
 - (b) uploading a copy of the document in question to the web page referred to in paragraph (4)(b) above.
- (7) The Claimants shall by no later than 25 July 2025 apply to the Court for an extension of this order or for a final order (such application to be served in accordance with paragraph (6) above).
- (8) If the Claimants intend to take enforcement proceedings against any person in respect of this Order, the Claimants shall, no later than the time of issuing such proceedings, serve on that person copies of:-
 - (a) the Claim Form and all supporting documents relied on to obtain the Order dated 1 August 2023; and

(b)	the application notice dated 26 July 2024 and all supporting documents relied
	on to obtain this Order.

(9) The Court will consider whether to join the person served to the proceedings as a named Defendant and whether to make any further Order.
