On 30 July 2020, The Honourable Mr. Justice Soole granted an interim injunction to restrain the Defendants from entering or remaining upon the construction site known as Bankside Yards and as defined in the order of that date ("the Injunction"). The Injunction was expressed to last until 29 January 2021 or further order.

On 26 January 2021, The Honourable Mr. Justice Bourne extended the Injunction until 9 March 2021 or further order. When giving judgment the learned Judge referred to an expectation that the Honourable Mr. Justice Nicklin expected to deliver judgment in Various Local Authority Claimants v Persons Unknown within 4 weeks of a hearing on 27 / 28 January 2021.

Due to pressure of work and the many issues that this case has raised, I am informed by Steven Woolf of Counsel, who is instructed on behalf of a number of the claimants, that the learned Judge has indicated that the handing down of his judgment will be delayed.

In any event, I also understand from Mr. Woolf that it is very likely that because of the many important issues in that case, there is every likelihood that subject to the grant of permission, an appeal to the Court of Appeal will follow.

On 4 March 2021, The Honourable Mr. Justice Stewart extended the Injunction until 4pm on 19 May 2021 or further order.


Pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Order of Mr. Justice Stewart dated 4 March 2021, in the event that the judgment of Mr. Justice Nicklin had not been handed down before 19 May 2021 or the judgment is subject to an appeal to the Court of Appeal or Supreme Court, the Claimants were granted permission to write to the Court to request a further extension of the Injunction.

The Claimants understand that the decision of Mr. Justice Nicklin has not yet been delivered and in the circumstances seek an extension to 15 October 2021. The Claimants have also suggested this date as it will avoid the need for a further application to be made over the vacation period. The

Claimants would also like to draw attention to the fact that each time an order is made, the Claimants are required to update the warning notices around the perimeter of the site, so therefore an extension to 15 October 2021 would be preferred.
