Kitchener's indoor recreation complex is a 220,000 square foot mixed-use recreational centre that will be located on 1664 Huron Road, Kitchener, Ontario. Construction started in early 2024 and will be complete in 2026.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Kitchener's indoor recreation complex is an Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) contract to deliver this recreation complex to the City of Kitchener.
- The facility will include many different amenities, all of which are planned and designed to support a greater diversity of sports and physical activities in the community.
- The following amenities are included in the initial plan:
 - (1) a FIFA-sized indoor turf fieldhouse that can be used for soccer, cricket, lacrosse and more.
 - (2) an indoor pool area that includes both a leisure pool and a lane pool.
 - (3) viewing galleries for the pool area.
 - (4) an indoor walking track around the perimeter of the indoor turf facility.
 - (5) two indoor cricket practice nets.
 - (6) multipurpose rooms for community events, parties and other rentals.
 - (7) Plans to include a future Quad gymnasium.
- The complex will be Kitchener's first net-zero carbon building and one of the most sustainable recreation facilities in Canada.
- The project is pursuing certification under the Canada Green Building Council Zero Carbon Building Standard v3 – Design (ZCB – Design), which is the highest level of certification for zero carbon building standards in Canada.
- The plans for the complex include a geothermal heating and cooling system, as well as our largest array of solar panels. These features will reduce 43 tonnes of carbon annually and save the city close to \$190,000 in utility costs every year.
- The building is over 220,000 square feet with a project budget of \$174 million.



PLEASE NOTE

There will be noise, dust and vibration associated with the construction of this project. Multiplex has a comprehensive control plan in place to mitigate the impact of construction on the community and will ensure all work is within acceptable levels and meets the requirements of all applicable by-laws.

UPCOMING ACTIVITIES July - September 2025

Our upcoming construction activities are:

Aquatic Centre:

- Metal siding is ongoing
- Stainless pools welding well is in progress.
- Mechanical and electrical works commenced

Atrium:

- Slab on grade in lobby.
- Mechanical & electrical works commenced.
- Curtain wall installation to commence.

Field House:

- Cross Laminated Timber (CLT) installation commenced.
- Roofing work commenced.
- Perimeter walking track is in progress.

Exterior:

- North parking lot landscaping commenced.

Gym:

- Structural Steel work commenced.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

June 16th marked the completion of the project's steel framework. Crowned with a symbolic tree and the flags of Walters Group, Union Ironworkers Local 736, Canada, and Multiplex, the final beam was hoisted approximately 17 meters above the fieldhouse structure at Kitchener's indoor recreation complex.
