The Quay is a 325,000 square feet mixed use project located at 350-396 Queens Quay West, Toronto that will add 340 new rental homes to the local Waterfront community. Construction started June 1st, 2021 and will take three years to complete.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Construction of a new, 21-storey building at 370 which includes 263 new units, a new exercise room and pool deck
- Extension of the north side of the existing building at 350 to add 77 new units (four units per floor). New passage way within existing building.
- Corridor refurbishment to all floors 350 and 390
- Underground utilities and services works. There will not be any disruption to resident's or businesses services during these works.

PLEASE NOTE

There will be noise, dust and vibration associated with the construction of this project. Multiplex has a comprehensive control plan in place to mitigate the impact of construction on the community and will ensure all work is within acceptable levels and meets the requirements of all applicable by-laws.

PROGRESS UPDATE

Construction started on site in June 1st, 2021. Work completed to-date includes:

- Buildings 370 & 350 are topped out.
- Building 370 architectural precast panels installation is substantially complete.
- Building 350 architectural precast panels installation on North and West façades is complete. East façade to start late April 2024.
- Building 350 expansion windows installation is complete on the West and North façades. East façade to start mid May 2024.
- Building 370 windows installation is substantially complete.
- Roofing work on the existing Building 350 and 390 roofs is substantially complete.
- Structural canopy framing on Building 350 and 390 roofs is complete. Decking installation on the both existing buildings is underway.
- Building 350 and 390 South retail areas are under construction. Exterior envelop works are well underway and starting interior fit out in Building 390 in April.
- Landscape work is in progress within Buildings 350 and 390 South retail areas, South stairs & North side of Peter Street Basin.
- Enbridge Gas distribution piping installation is complete to the new meter.
- Toronto Hydro power connection and main electrical room in building 370 energization is in progress.

April – June 2024

- Building 350/390 south retail exterior and interior works on going.
- Building 390/350 rooftop completion.
- Building 370 pre-cast façade to be substantially complete.
- Building 370 exterior window walls and curtain walls installation is underway on ground floor, 2nd floor, 7th floor and 21st floor.
- Building 370 interior demising walls and drywall assemblies installation in progress.
- Energization of main electrical room.
- Tower crane 1 dismantling.

The community will receive regular project updates and activity- specific notifications throughout construction.
